

All participants shall be subject to the terms and conditions set forth below, or such other rules as Church Team Ministries International (CTMI) may see fit to establish.



- 1. The **online registration form** must be filled in by a parent of the participant by 17th of December 2025.
- 2. A **photo** of the **Consent Forms for Minors** completed by one of the participant's parents, should be sent via WhatsApp to your regional youth coordinator.
- 3. CTMI's Teen's Camp is open to anyone **born in, or between 2011 and 2014**, and in **good physical and mental health**. CTMI reserves the right to accept participation outside of the age range mentioned above.
- 4. Submission of your child's registration form and payment (partial or full) does not mean that the application has been approved. CTMI reserves the right to refuse an application, even without reason. In the event that the application is rejected, you will be notified in writing and CTMI will reimburse you for the amount you have paid. If you do not receive a negative response from CTMI by December 20 2025, you may consider your child's application approved.
- 5. The discovery of a new and undisclosed fact in the participant's file will be considered a violation of the conditions of enrollment and may be sanctioned by a rejection of the participant's application.



B. PARTICIPATION FEES AND PAYMENT TERMS

- 1. Participation fees:
- Early Bird Fee: Rs 4500

The first minimum payment is made before 10th November 2025.

· Normal Fee: Rs 5000

The full payment is made before 17th December 2025.

- 2. First minimum payment: Rs 2000 (Non refundable)
- 3. Payments can be made:
 - (a) In cash, in an envelope with the participant's name to be given to your regional youth responsible or
 - (b) **Online,** to the following MCB account: **000020129025**Please put in the payment **description**: "**TC25**: **Name Surname**" (Name and Surname of the participant) and send a **screenshot** of the payment to your regional youth responsible.
- 4. Deadline to complete camp payment: December 17, 2025
- 5. CTMI reserves the right to revise the price upward if necessary.



- 6. In case of cancellation, any registrant will be entitled to recover the participation fee paid minus Rs 2000 corresponding to the non-refundable portion of the registration fee. **CTMI must be informed in writing no later than December 15, 2025**. After this date, no refund will be made.
- 7. The participation fee <u>includes</u> lodging, meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), transportation (from your local church to the camp).
- 8. The participation fee excludes:
 - (a) Any general accident, personal or medical insurance, hospitalisation, medical transportation, loss or damage to personal belongings, laundry service. Each participant is strongly advised to purchase all risk insurance for the duration of the camp to ensure coverage.
 - (b) The cost of repairing damage or other forms of voluntary or involuntary degradation caused by the participant on the infrastructure or assault and injury of other participants.
 - (c) Partial or total reimbursement of participation fees
 - (i) in case of dismissal due to non-compliance with the camp rules
 - (ii) in case of cancellation by the participant after December 17, 2025,
 - (iii) in the event of a natural disaster forcing CTMI to cancel the camp.
 - (d) The responsibility of CTMI or its representatives in case of loss or theft of personal effects and valuables of the participants.



CTMI will organise transportation from your local church to the camp and the return to your local church. For more information (meeting place, schedule) please contact your regional youth coordinators. Please note that transportation from your home to your local church will not be arranged for you by CTMI.



D. DEPARTURE AND ARRIVAL

- 1. The camp will be held from December 25 to 28, 2025.
- 2. Campers must be at the Centre Adventiste de Belle Mare by 10:00 am on Thursday, December 25, 2025.
- 3. Campers will leave the Centre Adventiste de Belle Mare at 11:00 am on Sunday, December 28, 2025.
- 4. Unless otherwise agreed upon, no participation less than the 4 days of camp will be accepted. In this event, full payment of the registration fee will also be due.



E. CAMP PROGRAM, RULES & REGULATIONS

Participants will take part in team building activities, workshops and meetings.
Each camp participant will be required to:

(a) Meetings/Activities:

- (i) Participate in all camp activities.
- (ii) Be present at the location and time agreed upon by the team leaders and camp leaders.
- (iii) Respect the instructions given by his/her team leader.

(b) Rooms:

- (i) Comply with the instructions given by his/her room responsible.
- (ii) Attend only to his/her room.
- (iii) Return to his/her room at 20:30, lights out at 21:00.

(c) Meals:

- (i) Eat at all meals.
- (ii) Drink water regularly.

(d) Dress code:

- (i) Dress appropriately and decently.
- (ii) Wear clean clothes.
- (iii) Wear a cap during outdoor activities.

(e) Personal hygiene:

- (i) Shower daily, without staying in the shower for too long.
- (ii) Make sure not to have lice when coming to camp.

(f) Health:

- (i) Be in good health when coming to camp.
- (ii) Provide a medical prescription and a letter from the parents for any long-term treatment (e.g. asthma pump) to be taken during the camp.

(g) Safety:

- (i) Stay within the camp grounds except for organised outings.
- (ii) Be responsible for personal belongings. CTMI will not be held responsible for the loss or theft of personal property.

(h) Environment:

- (i) Respect and not damage the green spaces, the premises, the sports equipment, the furniture, the water fountains as well as the mattresses which are common property.
- (ii) Use the garbage bins provided.
- 2. Camp participants <u>must not have</u> in their possession any of the following: game consoles, cell phones, music players, tablets, photo or video cameras, jewellery or other valuable items, sharp objects or any other personal items not needed at camp.
- 3. For safety reasons, no visits from parents or family members will be allowed, except in case of emergency.
- 4. In the event of a major health concern, parents will be notified by the camp leaders.
- 5. In case of misconduct and/or lack of respect for the rules of communal life, the parents will be notified and will be responsible for retrieving their child. In case of dismissal, no refund will be given.



H. IMAGE RIGHTS

By completing the registration form, I hereby understand and agree that, during camp, the image(s) of my minor child (hereinafter referred to as photo(s) or video film(s)), featuring his/her likeness may appear in a CTMI (Church Team Ministries International) product. I grant CTMI the following exclusive and irrevocable rights in perpetuity and throughout the world:

- 1. To use, reuse, publish and republish, modify or alter, and copyright images of my child, or in which my child may be included, as contained in the image(s) or video(s) in a CTMI product for editorial, commercial, advertising, broadcast, publication, or any other purpose, in any medium now in existence or that may be developed in the future for such product.
- 2. To use, reuse, publish and republish, the photo(s) or video(s) containing image(s) of my child, in whole or in part, individually in connection with printed materials, or in composite form for such product.
- 3. When the final edition of the photo(s) and/or video(s) is published, only first names may be used.
- 4. To periodically archive the images or video(s) taken by CTMI, its managers, photographers and film crew, but these images and films may be used for presentations or special occasions.
- 5. To the extent necessary, to print only my child's first name. I waive my right to inspect or approve any editorial or publicity copy that is used in connection with the photo(s) and video(s) and I release CTMI, its officers, photographers and crew from any and all claims arising out of their use by CTMI, its officers, photographers and crew for the purposes described above including any and all defamation and invasion of privacy suits.
